Animals brought in dead on arrival do not count in our totals. Release rate is based on animals not transferred to another facility.* Raptors are often transferred to Carolina Raptor Center. Pending animals are counted when released or placed in a permanent facility. Domesticated placed in a facility are counted as released. The mortality rate on small birds and mammals is high due to cat attack.
